GUIDELINES FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS

The VSCC of WA is keen to encourage the recording of its events and securing its history. The Club can provide photographers with a calendar of events, allows free entry, and endeavours to allow photographers the best possible access to events. The safety of ALL people attending events is however the overriding consideration in all decisions the club makes and it is asked that photographers understand our requirements and accept their responsibilities with regard to the management of risk, their own safety and Occupational Health and Safety obligations.

Access and Apparel

Level 1 Photographers

Photographers with appropriate state or national level CAMS Photographers Accreditation have open access to all safe areas at VSCC of WA events as designated on plans provided and/or as determined by the Clerk of Course for the event, or his representative. The circuit or course may be crossed when it is 'open' or when the Safety Car is on the course.

Level 1 photographers are required to provide and wear a **Green safety vest** at all times unless instructed otherwise by the organizers, and must carry their CAMS credentials at all times.

Level 2 Photographers

This category covers photographers not holding CAMS Accreditation. Access is the same as for Level 1 Photographers. Level 2 photographers are required to supply and wear an **Orange safety vest** at all times.

General

1. Indemnity Forms at the Event Office are to be completed and signed before entering the course.
2. Photographers must attend a briefing prior to the event.
3. The VSCC of WA reserves the right to limit the number of Level 2 photographers if deemed necessary.
4. Long pants, sleeved shirts, and enclosed footwear are required.
5. During events all photographers must remain behind the first line of defense unless written permission is obtained from the organizers. Arms and legs must not be hung over walls or barriers. Items dropped into a 'hot' area cannot be retrieved until the Safety car is on the course or the course is open.
6. Photographers are asked to agree, if requested, to supply to the club at no charge, clearly identified copies of photographs or other records taken [preferably on CD or DVD] for its own use with acknowledgement of the photographer/organization, as well as details of any media articles , videos or other publications of VSCC of WA events recorded.
