    - i. was a very successful event with 61 cars, 81 drivers and 30 motorcycles entered.
    - ii. There were around 5,000 spectators on the Saturday.
    - iii. He acknowledged the hard work of Graeme Cocks and Ross and Lynn Oxwell in making the event a success.
  - d. **Annual General Meeting:**
    - i. Monday 4 November, in conjunction with monthly meeting.
    - ii. Nominations for committee positions are due tonight.
  - e. **Albany Classic:**
    - i. The Albany Organising Committee proposes to become incorporated as the Albany Classic Motorsports Club and has asked to take over running of the event.
    - ii. The Management Committee will consider the proposal at tomorrow night's meeting.
9. **State of Play Reports:**
  - **Competition:**
    - a. **Collie Coalfields 500** – Glenn Swarbrick reported that:
      - i. There have been 110 entries to date.
      - ii. Peter Marsh at Race Car Restorations has offered sponsorship.
    - b. **CAMS** – Paul Bartlett reported that the State Council meeting last Thursday was cancelled due to the lack of a quorum; another meeting is scheduled for 24 October.
  - **Workshop:** Ron Fabry reported that:
    - a. The French car club visit to Caversham last weekend was very successful; he thanked the VSCC members who displayed their cars.

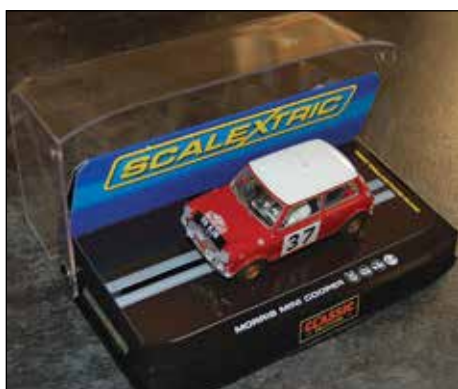
